

Notification of

Director of the Doctoral School of Exact and Natural Sciences at Jagiellonian University

dated 13 October 2020

Binding regulations and implemented operational procedures during the COVID-19 threat.

If any of the below symptoms are observable:

- fever (over 38°C), cough, shortness of breath, respiratory problems, sore muscles, general fatigue, loss of smell and taste

and the SARS-CoV-2 infection is suspected, a doctoral student should:

- stay in the place of his/her residence,
- notify the direct superior (supervisor, head of department, director of the institute or head, director of the doctoral school) via telephone or email,
- arrange an online doctor's appointment or call your nearest sanitary and epidemiological centre (WSSE in Cracow: 667 881 188 (emergency number)) and describe your symptoms.

It is the **doctoral students'** obligation to notify the **superior/supervisor/programme manager** of suspected and confirmed infection. The programme manager further sends such information at covid.sdnsip@uj.edu.pl.

I urge all of you to act reasonably in the light of accelerating pandemic and show your good will. If you feel unwell and observe any symptoms of infection, kindly notify the persons you have directly met in the course of the following week, and - if possible - arrange online classes.

Please observe the rules in place and refrain from gathering in rooms of departments in which you are conducting your research projects. The offices should be contacted via telephone or email. Please make sure to disinfect the premises in which classes were held.

At the same time, I urge you to follow the operational rules established by the University (Notification no. 27 of the Vice-rector for Educational Affairs -link) in the departments and external units where the classes within the given programme are conducted.

Please keep in mind that it is obligatory to cover your nose and mouth and social distance in public.
