

**REGULATIONS OF THE COMPETITION FOR THE ADVERTISING POSTER OF
THE DOCTORAL SCHOOL OF EXACT AND NATURAL SCIENCES AT
JAGIELLONIAN UNIVERSITY, AS WELL AS ADVERTISING POSTERS FOR
EACH OF THE PHD STUDY PROGRAMMES**

§ I

Organizer of the Competition

1. The Regulations (hereinafter referred to as: "Regulations") set the rules of participation in the Competition for the graphic design of an advertising poster of the Doctoral School of Exact and Natural Sciences of the Jagiellonian University (A) and advertising posters for each of the PhD study programmes (B) - hereinafter referred to as the "Competition".
2. The Organizer of the Competition and the entity promising a prize within the meaning of Art. 919 and 921 of the Civil Code is the Jagiellonian University - Doctoral School of Exact and Natural Sciences, hereinafter referred to as the "Organizer". Doctoral School of Exact and Natural Sciences at Jagiellonian University is hereinafter referred to as the "School".

§ II

The date of the Competition

1. The Competition begins on April 15th 2021 and ends on May 14th 2021 (the last day to announce results of the Competition).
2. Participants may apply for the Competition **from April 15th 2021 to May 7th 2021, by 11:59 PM.**
3. Competition works shall be delivered in electronic form to the School Secretariat to the following e-mail address: **sekretariatsdnsip@uj.edu.pl** along with a legibly signed Application (scan of the signed Appendix No. 1 of the Regulations of the Competition).
4. Participation in the Competition is free and completely voluntary.
5. All costs related to the participation in the Competition shall be borne by the Participant.

§ III

Competition task

1. The competition task is to design an advertising poster of the Doctoral School of Exact and Natural Sciences of the Jagiellonian University (A) and advertising posters for each of the PhD study programmes (B) - hereinafter jointly referred to as the "Poster".
2. The Poster shall include the following elements:
 - logo of the Jagiellonian University (link to the website with high quality files for download: <https://promocja.uj.edu.pl/system-identyfikacji-wizualnej/pliki-do-pobrania>).
 - If the logo of the Jagiellonian University does not contain the words, the words "Jagiellonian University" or "Uniwersytet Jagielloński" shall be added separately.
 - name of the school,
 - school website address: <https://science.phd.uj.edu.pl>,
 - on the poster for a given PhD study programme, the full or abbreviated name of this programme.
 - The work shall bear an emblem.
3. Works with the emblem shall not reveal the identity of their authors. The School Secretariat submits the delivered works to the competition committee without any information allowing the identification of their authors.
4. Competition work in an electronic form that meets the requirements referred to in paragraph 2 shall be submitted to the Organizer pursuant to § II para 3. Each participant may submit one work in part A and part B of the Competition.

§ IV

Conditions for participation

1. To become a Participant, you shall make a Poster in accordance with the Regulations and submit it to the Organizer along with the Application (Annex No. 1) within the period specified in § II section 2 of the Regulations.
2. Doctoral Students of the Doctoral School of Exact and Natural Sciences at Jagiellonian University can be participants of the Competition.

3. The Participant shall declare that the Organizer shall be entitled to process the pieces of work used in the competition work, without the need to obtain separate licenses and consents in this regard.
4. Participants who do not meet the rules set out in the Regulations and/or whose competition works do not meet the requirements set out in the Regulations shall not be allowed to participate in the Competition.

§ IV

Evaluation of works

1. Works that meet the requirements set out in the Regulations shall be evaluated according to the following criteria: graphic value, promotional value, originality of the project, legibility of the project.
2. The works shall be evaluated by a Competition Committee appointed by the School Director, which will include persons representing PhD study programmes, indicated by the managers of these programmes and by the School Director. The Competition Committee shall choose the best works in each of the competition categories and will make decisions regarding awarding or not awarding these works with the prizes described in § VII sec. 1.
3. The decision of the Competition Committee is final and may not be appealed against.
4. The tasks of the Competition Committee also include the evaluation of the correctness of the Applications for participation in the Competition.
5. The Competition Committee shall prepare a protocol from the meeting in which the results are announced.
6. The Organizer of the Competition reserves the right not to settle the Competition if the competition works are not submitted or the submitted works do not meet the requirements of the Regulations.

§ VI

Results announcement

1. The results shall be announced by May 14th 2021.
2. The results of the Competition shall be announced via the website: science.phd.uj.edu.pl. The winning posters shall also be posted on the website and on the School's Facebook account.
3. The Organizer reserves the right to contact selected authors of works submitted to the competition. The Organizer is not obliged to inform other Participants about the results of the Competition in addition to the announcement referred to in the section above. The Organizer shall contact the winner of the competition via e-mail or telephone.
4. The winning poster shall be used by the Organizer to advertise the School.

§ VII

The prize and the contract with the Competition Winner

1. The Participant whose work takes first or second place in the Competition shall be awarded a cash prize:
in the case of a poster advertising a given school PhD study programme, the Committee may award the first (PLN 500) and the second (PLN 300) prize;
for a poster advertising the school, the amount of the first prize is PLN 1,000, and the second prize is PLN 500.
2. The participant whose competition work took first or second place in the Competition shall be invited by the Organizer to sign a contract for the transfer to the Organizer of author's rights to the Poster for the promotion of the School in the fields of use specified in detail in the contract transferring proprietary copyrights, author's rights to the Poster.
3. The Participant whose work has won the Competition is not entitled to a separate remuneration in accordance with the contract specified in sec. 2 using it in each separate field of exploitation.

§ VIII

Personal data protection

Pursuant to Art. 13 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the

free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation, hereinafter referred to as GDPR), the Jagiellonian University informs that:

1. **The Controller** of your personal data is the Jagiellonian University, ul. Gołębia 24, 31-007 Kraków, represented by the Rector of the Jagiellonian University.
2. **The Jagiellonian University appointed the Data Protection Officer**, ul. Gołębia 24, 30-007 Kraków, room No. 31. Contact with the Data Protection Officer is possible via e-mail: iod@uj.edu.pl or via phone call 12 663 12 25, from Monday to Friday, from 8:00 AM to 03:00 PM.
3. Your personal data provided in the Application Form shall be processed:
 - a. in the case of all Participants - for the **organizational purposes, conducting the Competition** (hereinafter referred to as the "Competition") pursuant to Art. 6 sec. 1 point f of the GDPR - i.e. in the performance of the Controller's legitimate interest in selecting a winner in the competition, with whom a contractual relationship shall then be established;
 - b. in the case of a Participant who is the author of the awarded competition work - in order to fulfill the legal obligations imposed on the Organizer as the one promising the award, including in particular tax obligations, i.e. pursuant to Art. 6 sec. 1 point c of the GDPR.
4. Providing your personal data is voluntary, but necessary to participate in the Competition. Failure to provide personal data may result in the inability to participate in the Competition. In the case of the Participants referred to in section 3 point b above, providing the data is a legal obligation, and failure to do so shall make it impossible to award the Participant.
5. Personal data of the Participants referred to in section 3 point a above shall not be shared with entities outside the Organizer's staff.
6. Personal data of the Participants referred to in section 3 point b above may be posted on the Organizer's website and in the Organizer's social media due to the designation of the winning Poster and the recognition of author's rights. The data shall also be shared with authorized state authorities, in particular to the extent to which these authorities are entitled to verify the fulfillment of legal obligations imposed on the Organizer as a entity promising the award.
7. Your personal data shall not be transferred to third countries (outside the European Economic Area) or to international organizations.
8. Personal data of the Participants referred to in section 3 point a above shall be processed until the Competition is settled and information about its settlement is provided. Personal data of the Participants referred to in section 3 point b above shall be processed for the period provided for by tax regulations, and then for archival purposes in accordance with the applicable law. These data shall still be processed on the basis of a contract concluded with the winners of the Competition.
9. You have the right to: obtain information on the processing of personal data and rights under the GDPR, access and rectify your data, as well as the right to delete personal data from the controller's files (unless further processing is necessary to fulfill a legal obligation or to establish, investigate or defend claims), and the right to limit processing, transfer data, object to processing - in the cases and under the conditions specified in the GDPR.
10. Your personal data shall not be subject to automatic decision making or profiling.
11. You have the right to lodge a complaint with the President of the Personal Data Protection Office if you believe that the processing of your personal data violates the provisions of the GDPR.

§ IX

Final provisions

1. The Organizer of the Competition reserves the right to amend the Regulations or cancel the Competition. The Organizer shall announce the cancellation of the Competition or the amendments to the Regulations in the same way as the Competition was announced, i.e. by publishing information, inter alia, on the website <https://science.phd.uj.edu.pl>
2. The Organizer may cancel the competition if no competition works have been submitted or those that did not meet the requirements set out in the Regulations, as well as in the event that the applicable regulations are amended preventing the Competition from being conducted or if the Competition becomes impossible due to vis maior.
3. All disputes shall be settled by the Competition Organizer.
